

## **SECTION 3 FLORAL ARRANGEMENTS**

**PRIZES: 1<sup>st</sup> - £1; 2<sup>nd</sup> - 60p; 3<sup>rd</sup> - 40p - unless otherwise stated**

### **Class**

- 301. Exhibit of foliate, berries and seed heads in any container (No accessories allowed)
- 302. An arrangement of flower heads floating in a dish (not exceeding 25cm)
- 303. An artistic miniature garden not exceeding 50cm x 50cm (using only natural materials)
- 304. “Harvest” – An arrangement using natural materials, fruit and vegetables (no accessories)
- 305. Arrangement of flowers and foliage in a jug (no accessories). Open to anyone who has not previously won a trophy in Section 3.
- 306. “Pretty petite” – an exhibit **not exceeding 15cm in height, width or depth**
- 307. A basket of fresh flowers, minimum foliage, **basket with handle not to exceed 25cm in width or depth.**

### **Notes:**

- Flowers need not be grown personally by the exhibitor
- No artificial flowers or plant material.
- No accessories allowed (other than containers)
- Exhibitors must try to hide any oasis used.

- **The Vale Trophy** – Best Exhibit in classes 301-307
